

Know your HIV Status

Getting tested and knowing your HIV status helps keep you and your partner(s) healthy. Talk with your healthcare provider about getting tested today.



If any of the following apply to you, you should be tested for HIV at least once a year:



You're a man who has had sex with another man.



You've had sex with a partner who has HIV.



You've had more than one partner since your last HIV test.



You've shared needles, syringes, or other equipment to inject drugs.



You've exchanged sex for drugs or money.



You have another sexually transmitted disease.



You've had sex with anyone who has done anything listed above or with someone whose sexual history you don't know.



Did You Know?

With antiretroviral therapy, people who have HIV can live long and healthy lives.
